Iran's construction sector is poised for robust growth in the wake of sanctions removal, equally driven primarily by an influx of international investment and a post-sanctions financial windfall. Both transport and energy sectors are expected to attract in particular the lion's share of investment.


Italy's state-owned highway management firm Anas signed a deal with the Iranian Ministry of Roads to build and manage a **1,200km** road in the country. The **EUR 3.6 billion** (USD 4bn) project involves building a road connecting the port of Bandar Imam Khomeini to Bazargah.

UNIT

UNIT International signed a USD 4.2bn deal on June 1 with the Iranian energy ministry to build seven natural gas-fired power plants in Iran.


